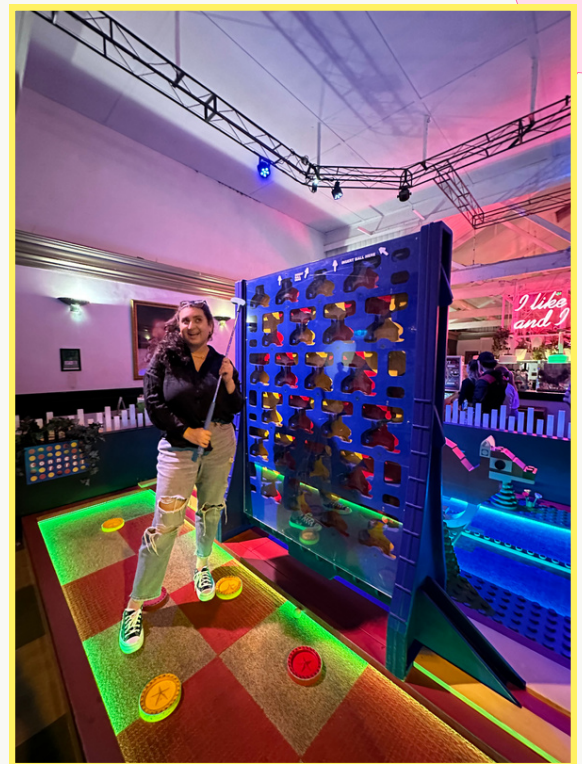

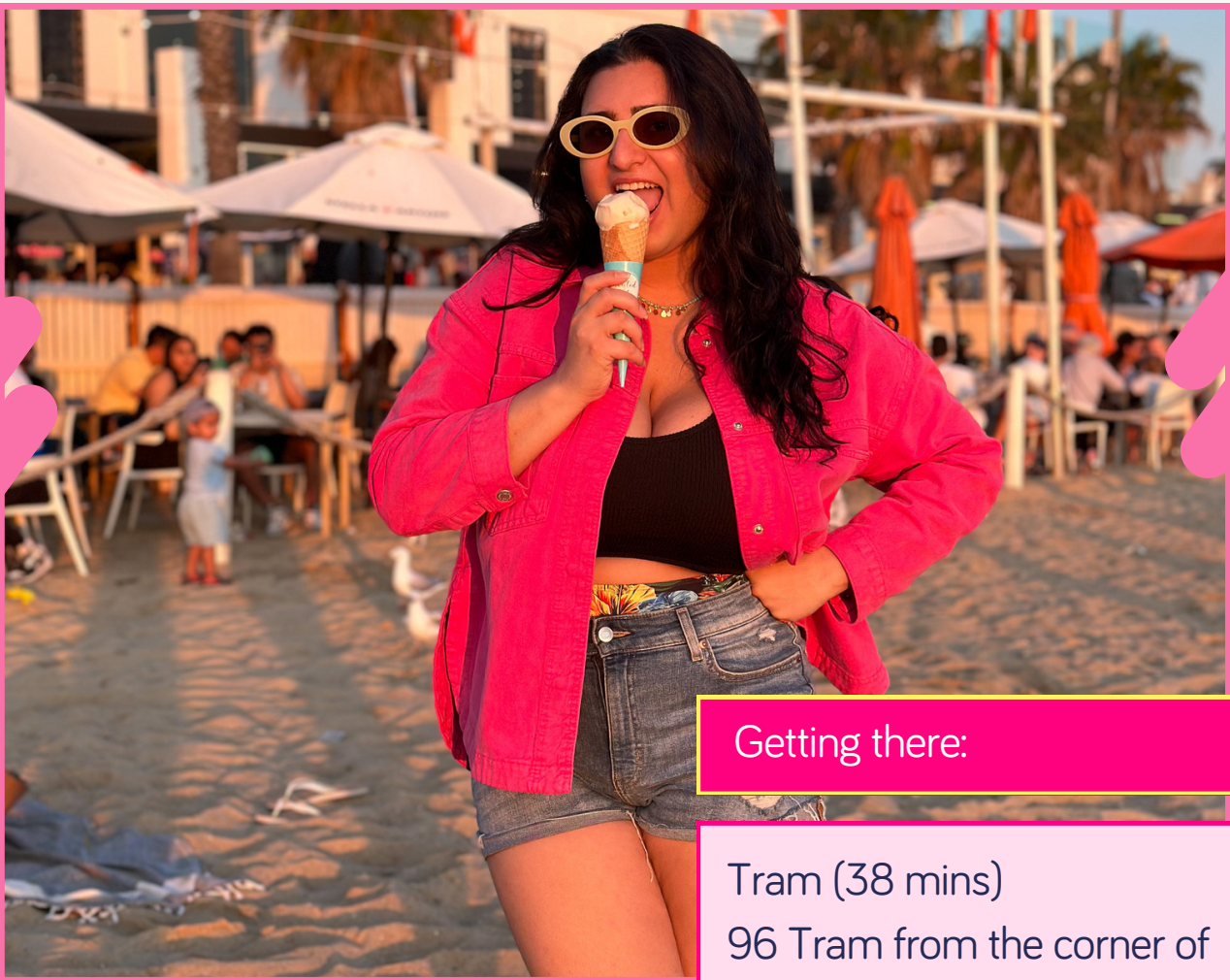

Getting there:

Drive (1hr 17min)

Travel from Melbourne City onto the Westgate Freeway, continue onto Princes Freeway, continue onto Geelong Ring Road then follow the signs for Torquay. You can choose to head to the coast or explore the hinterland by continuing on the Princes Highway (A1) or explore the quieter country roads.

Train (2hr 40min)

Train services operated by V/Line are available from Melbourne to Geelong or Warrnambool, stopping along the way in many of the major hinterland towns including Winchelsea and Colac.

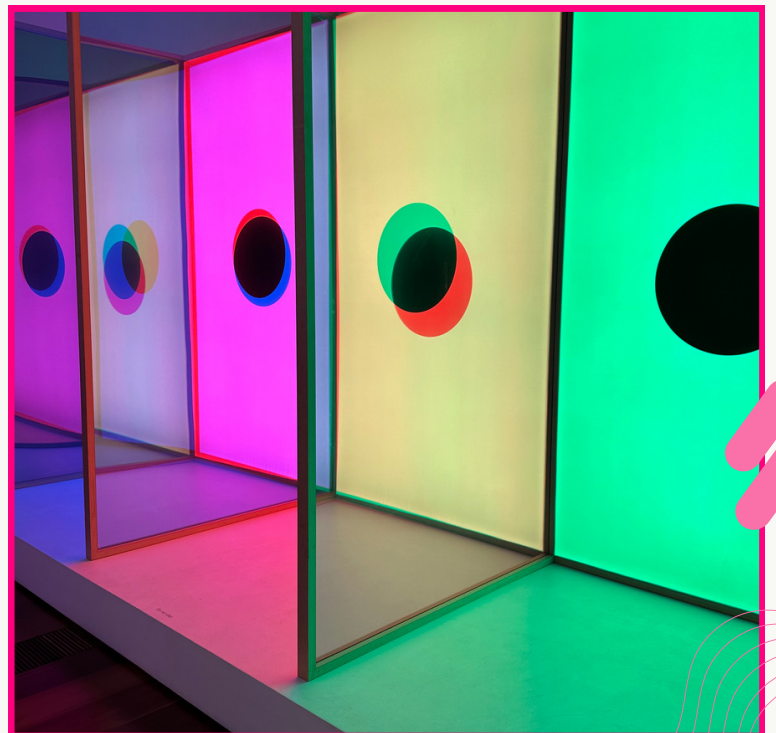
Top 3 free things to do
